The Department of Physics at UCSD (<http://www-physics.ucsd.edu/>) invites applications from qualified individuals for a **tenured Full Professorship** in **theoretical Biological Physics**. The successful candidate is expected to have a strong theoretical physics background, a broad interest in biological physics, and a world-class research program complementing existing strengths at the NSF-supported Center for Theoretical Biological Physics. This search is an integral component of a multi-year, campus-wide effort to develop a preeminent program in the area of Quantitative Biology (qBio), and the successful candidate will help to steer future development of the qBio initiative in collaborations with other departments including Biology, and such UCSD organizations as the NIH Center of Excellence in Systems Biology, the San Diego Supercomputer Center, the BioCircuits Institute, and interdepartmental graduate programs at the interface of the physical and biological sciences. All candidates must have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in Physics or a closely related field, and will be evaluated on research and teaching accomplishments, as well as a demonstrated commitment to excellence by providing leadership in teaching, research, or service toward building an equitable and diverse scholarly environment..
